Project description: This small quilt offers a unique opportunity to hone exactness in sewing skills while making a quilt that will fit in a ready-made 16 \times 20 inch frame for display.

<u>REQUIRED</u> Pattern: From My Heart to Your Hands Set 12 by Lori Smith Circle of Friends Quilt

Fabric requirements: Mine was made from scraps. FUse scraps if you have them. Each block uses one fabric type. Or we will be using triangle paper to make the half square triangles, have 1/8 yard of 12 different fabrics for the backgrounds and a fat quarter of the circle fabric. If you are going to put this into a frame, don't worry about backing or binding fabric yet.

Sewing supplies:

- 1. A sharp Rotary cutter
- 2. 18 inch and 6-8 inch rulers
- 3. Smaller sized mat
- 4. 15 medium sized plastic bags
- 5. Thread
- 6. Small scissors for clipping threads
- 7. I will provide the triangle paper.
