Project description: Another Elizabeth Hartman pattern featuring whimsical and colorful pineapples. Use colorful and cohesive color groups of fat quarters to piece these sweet pineapples. Class project Baby Quilt will finish 35" x 43".

REQUIRED Pattern: PINEAPPLE FARM/ PATTERN BY ELIZABETH HARTMAN

Fabric requirements for the Baby Quilt listed on the back page of the pattern:

- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yd of Background Fabric
- 6 Fat Quarters Colorful Fabrics for Pineapple Bodies
- 2 Fat Quarters for the Leaves. I used both greens and colors
- 1 $\frac{3}{8}$ yd of Backing Fabric
- $\frac{3}{8}$ yd Binding Fabric
- 38" x 46" Batting

Sewing Supplies:

1. Rotary cutter ruler and mat
2. Sewing machine and accessories including a $\frac{1}{4}$ foot for piecing
3. Neutral thread
4. Scissors to clip threads
5. Plastic baggies (small)/ clips/ or pins to label all the Pineapple body and leave pieces.
6. Angler Tool for piecing the leaves

Prior to class: Please follow the cutting directions as noted on pages 13/14. You will need 3 color cohesive fat quarters to make a pineapple body block ie (using 3 yellows). Stack 3 fat quarters for the bodies and refer to the chart on page 13 and diagram on page 14 to cut pieces A-L. stop. Label each piece set. We will re-arrange the placement of the pieces in class.

For the Pineapple Leaves use 1 fat quarter. Refer to the cutting directions on page 13/14 to cut pieces M-O. Label each piece set.

For the Background fabric used to piece the leaves, refer to page 1. For piece Q - cut 1 strip 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x LOF (length of fabric) and subcut: 6 pieces Q, 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " each. For piece R - cut 4 strips 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x LOF and subcut: 120 pieces R, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " each. For piece S - cut 1 strip 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x LOF and sub cut: 6 pieces S, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" each.
