Project description: Make a fun set of placemats using a new technique

Pattern/Book: Instructions will be given in class. No book or pattern is required.

Fabric requirements:

- 1-2" strips of cotton fabric. Leftover binding strips. Extra orphan jelly roll strips, or, buy yardage in coordinating colors. To learn the techniques, I suggest using what is in your stash to make a sample placemat.
- ***IMPORTANT***--If purchasing yardage, do not cut strips until class. You will want to experiment with the width of the strips when you learn the technique. I prefer 1" strips but some like the wider strips.
- See below for info on purchasing clothesline.

Sewing supplies:

- **YOUR SEWING MACHINE AND ACCESSORIES.** Be sure it is clean and in good working order.
- You will need a foot for straight stitching and one for zigzag.
- $\frac{1}{4}$ "- $\frac{3}{8}$ " clothesline or a size similar in diameter. All purpose cotton is fine. Bring at least 100 feet to get started. Try to avoid polyester or nylon rope if possible as it stretches!! A cotton poly blend is OK.
- **SEVERAL** jean or denim needles to fit your machine
- Neutral thread, sharp scissors.
- Your favorite sewing supplies
- A lunch or snack to share

Prior to class: If you are using strips that have been in your stash, they may need pressing. Flat strips are easier to wrap.
