Supply List

Project description: This raglan sleeve knit top gives us the opportunity to practice overlock, coverlock and lettuce edge techniques. The short sleeve version will be done in class.

REQUIRED Pattern: *KWIK SEW pattern 3954*

Fabric requirements: Fabric requirements are on the back of the pattern for all sizes. Please make sure that the fabric meets the stretch requirements on the back of the pattern! Please note that the pattern only lists 58" wide fabric. Some of our knits are 44" wide. All sizes of short sleeve top can be made with 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards of 44" wide fabric.

XS	1 $\frac{5}{8}$ yd
S	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yd
M	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yd
L	1 $\frac{7}{8}$ yd
XL	1 $\frac{7}{8}$ yd

Sewing supplies:

1. Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
2. Baby Lock Serger and all accessories
3. 4 Neutral serger threads for construction
4. 2 matching or complementary Serger threads for top stitching
5. Optional: 1 decorative thread for lettuce hem, or thread used for top stitching.
6. $\frac{1}{4}$ " fusible web
7. Scissors to clip threads

Prior to class:

Cut out fabric according to the pattern.

Project description: *This class is designed for you to use your Baby Lock serger to add pizzazz to a bolster pillow made in fabrics of your choice. The serger techniques include making piping, puffing strips, making double-fold fabric ties, and using the wave stitch for a professional looking pillow.*

All Tools and Sewing Supplies are available at Quilt Beginnings

Fabrics:

- 1/3 yard fabric for puffing strips;
- 1/4 yard coordinating fabric for pillow center
- 5/8 yard coordinating fabric for pillow ends
- 1 yard fabric for lining
- 1/2 yard solid color fabric for piping
- Fabric or ribbons of your choice for ties

Quilter's Learning Outcomes

At the end of this class, you will be able to

1. ruffle puff strips using a Baby Lock ruffling foot;
2. create fabric ties using 28mm double fold Baby Lock bias binder;
3. fashion with decorative threads for wave stitch; and
4. create piping for added decorative detail.

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Tools and Sewing supplies:

8. Book: *Cutting Edge Serger Techniques*, by Barbara Goldkorn;
9. Bolster pillow form 19-inch;
10. Fabric for pillow (See page 51 of *Serger Techniques*);
11. 5 yards 3/32"-wide cotton cording;
12. Cover/chain stitch foot or ruffling foot (Baby Lock);
13. Cording foot;
14. 28 mm double fold bias binder (Baby Lock);
15. Fabric stiffener (Best Press);
16. 4 spools regular serger thread;
17. 90/14 serger needles;
18. 8 decorative beads;
19. 2 spools heavy decorative thread;
20. 2 spools heavy decorative thread for wave stitch;
21. Rotary cutter, ruler, and mat;
22. Baby Lock serger, pedal, and electric cord;
23. Scissors to trim threads;
24. Clover Wonder Clips;
25. Straight Pins;
26. Seam ripper; and
27. Small iron and pressing surface.

Class Preparation

1. Gather supplies and tools for class as stated above. QB staff will help you.
2. Press your fabrics. Use Best Press to remove wrinkles from the fabrics.
(Don't prewash)
3. Bring a snack and drink with lid.
