Project description:

Create this fun geometric pattern with very easy piecing. It's a great way to use your scraps or 2 packs of fat quarters. If you have an 8-inch AccuQuilt Qube, cutting will be a breeze!
Finished quilt size: 68" x 89"

Fabric requirements:

26 Fat Quarters (2 Fat quarter packs were sufficient) or equivalent amount of scraps
4 yards of background fabric
¾ yard binding
5 1/3 yards backing

Supplies:

- Tinker Toy Pattern
- Rotary cutter, long ruler and mat
- Sewing Machine and accessories
- ¼" sewing machine foot
- Neutral thread for top and bobbin for piecing
- 6 ½" square ruler

OPTIONAL

- If you have an AccuQuilt 8"-Qube, you will be delighted at how quickly and easily you can cut out this quilt!
- This is a great quilt to use your Nifty Notions Side Set Triangle Ruler (I love new tools!)
