



GoodNight Baby/Bear

Supply List

Dates: 10:00 am - 2:00 pm, Wednesday, September 26th

Project description: Make either a baby or Teddy with happy faces that flip over to a sleepy face. Their bodies are in a sleep-sack that fit into a bed.

Pattern: Goodnight Baby, Goodnight Bear

Fabric requirements: note: this is for one doll or Teddy if you want to make both double the list!!

1. *Felt for Doll head or Teddy head we will provide and yarn for doll hair*
2. Bring cotton fabric for the body 15 inches by 30 inches or $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
3. Also 1 yard of sf 101 interfacing
4. 100 2.5 inch squares for bed or a cotton cheater fabric
5. $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of cotton fabric for bed lining
6. A piece of batting at least 15 by 32 inches, craft batting will work
7. Fat-quarter of contrasting fabric for binding
8. Embroidery floss, dark brown or black for faces
9. Doll stuffing

Sewing supplies:

1. Sewing machine and accessories
2. Neutral thread, scissors to clip threads
3. Stiff paper to trace pattern, (tracing paper)
4. Pins
5. Good scissors for cutting fabric
6. Fabric marking pencil (friction)
7. Hand Embroidery needle
8. Turning tool I use a hemostat
9. Chopstick for stuffing

Prior to class: I would like you cut your 2.5 inch blocks and if you can sew them together 6 across by 15 down then we can quilt in class and spend most of our time making the doll/teddy!!
