**Pre-requisite:** Prior free motion or ruler work class or experience

**Project description:** Quilt the Amanda Murphy Ruler Work Panel using Westalee Rulers. Learn how to free motion quilt with rulers on a panel. Get ideas for quilting borders, nine patch, friendship stars, Dresden plates and more. Panel is included in cost of class. **Pick the panel up prior to class** so you can have your sampler sandwiched and ready to go. **Bring your lunch.**

**Book:** None required. Good Resource for quilting ideas is Amanda Murphy's Free Motion Quilting Idea Book or Rulerwork Quilting Idea Book

### Fabric & Ruler requirements

- Bernina Ruler Panel by Amanda Murphy (included in class fee—**pick up prior to class**)
- 1 & 1/2 yds backing (allow at least 2" larger on each side of panel)
- Batting (same size as backing fabric)
- Ruler foot in proper shank for your machine
- Extension table (Sew Steady or similar) to fit your machine
- Free motion glider
- Quilting gloves
- Rulers needed
  - Westalee Sampler Template Set 1 in proper shank height for your machine (6 piece set)
  - Ruler foot Starter Package in proper shank height for your machine (includes ruler foot, 12" Arc Ruler & Spacing gauge.
  - Westalee Circles on Quilts 2.5" to 11.5" - 2.5" & 3.5" Circle (circle templates optional--I will have a couple available to use during class)

**OR---** BERNINA OWNERS can use Bernina Ruler Kit for Sit-Down Machines

### Sewing supplies:

1. Sewing machine and accessories
2. Thread for quilting, white or color of your choice, scissors to clip threads
3. 90/14 Needle

## 4. Frixion Pen

**Prior to class:** Sandwich sampler, batting and backing so you are ready to quilt. I prefer spray basting so I don't have to mess with pins while using rulers.
