Supply List

Project description: A versatile Mesh Tote bag made with loads of serger techniques! A great bag and a great learning project.

Pattern: *Provided in class*

Materials

- 18" x 45" Mesh
- $\frac{3}{4}$ yard Main Fabric
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard accent fabric for bingings
- 1/8 yard Fusible Fleece
- 4 spools of serger thread to match mesh
- 1 solid and 1 variegated for Wave stitch (12 wt is best)
- 6 or 7 wt thread to match Wave thread
- 4 - 32mm Split Rings

Supplies:

- Serger, feet, accessories
 - 10 mm Non-woven bias binder
 - 15 mm Non-woven bias binder
 - 4-hole table
 - Curve foot
 - Open toe foot
 - Quilting bar
 - 90/14 needles
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat



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Prior to class: You MUST do this at least one day ahead!!!! Cut and prep fabric

Mesh:

1 - 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18" bottom

2 - 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12" sides

1 - 12" x 19" Backing for the pocket side

1 - 10" x 18" inside pocket

Main Fabric

1 - 12" x 18" Pocket Side. **This piece only**, spray starch until crisp. Let dry.

1 - 13" x 12" Flat Lock Wave Stitch

2 - 3" x 27" Straps

2 - 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x WOF Suspenders

Contrasting Fabric:

1 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" or more BIAS for binding

1 - 2" x WOF Straight of grain binding

Fusible Fleece:

2 - 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 27 straps

2 - 1" x 45" suspenders
