## Atomic Starburst Quilt

### Supply List

**Instructor:** Pam Churches

**Dates:** 10 a.m. - 1 p.m., Thursday, August 2<sup>nd</sup> and August 23<sup>rd</sup>

**Project description:** The Atomic Starburst Quilt is made by combining foundation paper pieced Starburst blocks with traditional piecing. Finished size is 62" x 66".

**Required Pattern:** *The Atomic Starburst Quilt* by Violet Craft

#### **Fabric requirements: Kits are available**

- 30 pieces of 7" x 12" fabric for diamonds (note: 3 diamonds can be cut from  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard of fabric; you may purchase 10 (quarter yard) cuts and have 3 diamonds each of 10 different colors instead of 30 different colors)
- 20 pieces of 6" x 8" fabric for starbursts (note: instead of choosing 20 different colors, you can purchase  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard cuts of four different fabrics; from each  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard you can cut (5) 6" x 8" rectangles)
- 4 1/4 yards background fabric
- 2/3 yard binding fabric
- 3.5 yards backing fabric
- Batting

#### **Other supplies:**

- One sheet of template plastic
- Sharpie marker to trace pattern
- Olfa Touch Knife to cut template plastic
- Acrylic ruler at least 12" long (or you will have to share)
- 6" or 12" add-a-quarter ruler required
- 1 package Simple Foundations Paper (translucent vellum)

#### **Sewing supplies:**

1. Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
2. Sewing machine and accessories
3. Neutral thread
4. Scissors to clip threads

**Prior to class:** Make 20 copies of starburst pattern on vellum; if you want us to make the copies, you must purchase the vellum listed above.
