Project description: Join Pam one Tuesday morning each month for an exciting lecture / demo, then stay to stitch out the featured project. You will receive that month's project design FREE, just for attending! You will receive your USB stick at your first class. Just bring it back for us to load your next design each month. Fabric kits will be provided each month for you to stitch in class. Fabric and stabilizer will be provided as well as use of embroidery threads.

You need to bring:

- Embroidery machine, embroidery unit, power cord and embroidery foot
- Projects may use either a 5"x7" hoop or larger. Be sure to bring larger hoops as well
- Water soluble pen or frixion pen
- Small sharp tip scissors for cutting appliques
- Machine needles
- Seam ripper
- 2 empty bobbins
- 1/2" steam a seam tape to close openings (otherwise opening must be hand stitched)
- RnK pink embroidery tape

Bring a show and tell for the lecture / demo portion of class to be entered into a drawing for a door prize.
