NOTE: YOU MUST HAVE AN EMBROIDERY MACHINE WITH A MINIMUM HOOP SIZE OF 5" X 7" IN ORDER TO COMPLETE THIS PROJECT.

Project description: Create a cute fox gift bag, completed entirely in the hoop. The required CD features four woodland animals, (bunny, raccoon fox, and owl) in five sizes, ranging from extra small to extra-large. The smallest size utilizes a 4" x 4" hoop while the largest sizes requires a 9" x 14" hoop. We will be creating the small bag in class which requires a 5" x 7" hoop.

Required CD: Kimberbell's *It's a Cinch Gift bags, Vol. 4, Woodland Animals*

Fabric requirements

- 9" x 21" piece of main fabric (fox)
- 9" x 11" piece of inner ear fabric
- 9" x 11" piece of face fabric
- 1 yard of 3/8" ribbon
- Embroidery tape (Kimberbell tape or RnK pink perfection tape)
- No show mesh to fit hoop
- Embroidery thread to match and contrast with ears and face details
- Empty bobbins for winding matching bobbin color or prewound bobbins

Sewing and embroidery supplies:

- Embroidery machine, embroidery unit, embroidery foot, and power cord.
- Thread snips and applique scissors
- 5" x 7" hoop
- Precision turning tool is helpful
- Loop turner for ribbon insertion tool is also helpful

Prior to class: Download your machine's file format for the small fox to a USB stick or your machine's memory. Print the instructions for "clever fox" and bring to class.
