TRIANGLE DELIGHT

Supply List

Dates: Saturday, July 22, 10a-3p

Project description: Learn how easy it is to create half square triangles! Scrappy or coordinated, it's your choice! I used 48 different fossil ferns, but you do not need to make it as scrappy as I did. 20 different fabrics also looks great! Add optional borders.

Required Pattern: *Triangle Delight*

Fabric requirements

- 40 assorted 10" squares (1 Layer cake) or 20 fat quarters
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard inner border
- $1 \frac{1}{2}$ yard outer border
- $\frac{3}{4}$ yard binding (or use a 2-1/2" piece from each fat quarter for a scrappy binding)
- $3 \frac{3}{4}$ yard backing
- 1 roll of 4" triangle paper

Sewing supplies:

1. Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
2. Sewing machine and accessories
3. Neutral thread
4. Scissors to clip threads

Prior to class: If you are using a layer cake, there is no prep work!

If you are using fat quarters, please cut 2- 10-1/4" squares out of EACH fat quarter, for a total of 40 squares. For a scrappy binding, cut one 2-1/2" strip x 21" from each fat quarter.
