Classic Curves Ruler Retreat

Project description: Master curved piecing in this two day sewing retreat all about curvy quilts. You'll learn the basics and advantages to using the Classic Curves Ruler to cut your fabrics and tricks for successful curved piecing. Two pattern options offered, one for beginners (or a quick project for experienced quilters), one for more advanced piecing skills. You'll end the weekend with a finished or nearly finished quilt top!

Pattern: Mermaid (beginner friendly) or Indigo (for confident/advanced quilters) by Color Girl. Also required: Classic Curves Ruler for cutting.

Fabric requirements: Refer to the pattern for the size you choose to make.

Sewing supplies:

1. Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
2. Sewing machine and accessories
3. Neutral thread, scissors to clip threads
4. Pins
5. Classic Curves Ruler

Prior to class:

Before you arrive, please read your pattern and press your fabrics. Decide which quilt and size you plan to make and bring the necessary fabrics. You may choose to start cutting the squares. You will see a demonstration in the class for using the CCRuler at the class. You may start cutting ahead or wait until class. It is not recommended to cut all the fabrics before you start sewing, so if you want to get a bit of a head start, just cut some of your squares before class. You'll be ready to get started cutting the curved shapes at the beginning of class.
