Dates: 10 a.m. - 5 p.m., Wednesday March 14th and Thursday, March 15th

Project description: Learn multiple embroidery techniques while constructing this whimsical Kimberbell quilt. Finished size is approximately 52" x 67".

Please note that an embroidery machine with a minimum hoop size of 6" x 10" is required to complete this project

Required Pattern: *Kimberbell's Hello Sunshine!*

Fabric requirements

- Fabric requirements may be found on pages 2-5 in the pattern / book listed above
- Quilt Beginnings has 20 fat quarters of Kimberbell Basics available as a starter set for this project. You'll still need to purchase your choice of border fabrics and four $\frac{1}{2}$ yards of background fabrics.
- Embellishment requirements may be found on page 6 in the pattern /book listed above

Please note that embellishments are needed during the embroidery process; they ARE NOT added later

- 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards fabric for backing
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard fabric for binding
- Embroidery threads to match or contrast with your fabric choices
- Pre-wound bobbins and 2-3 empty bobbins

Sewing supplies:

1. Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
2. Embroidery machine, embroidery arm, embroidery foot, and power cord
3. 5 x 7 hoop and 6 x10 hoop (8 x 12) will work if you do not have a 6x10
4. Applique scissors to trim appliques; thread snips

Prior to class:

Transfer your machine's file format for the quilt to a USB stick or your machine's memory.
