Fabric requirements:

- Fabric and stabilizer are all provided as well as use of threads

Supplies:

So that you can start stitching right away, you'll want to pack a few supplies in your own sewing toolbox:

- Embroidery machine, embroidery arm, embroidery foot and power cord
- Projects are designed for 5x7 and 6x10 (or larger) hoops. Be sure to bring both. Bernina owners will need the Maxi or Mega Hoop, as well as the large oval for Kimberbell Event projects because of embroidery field dimensions.
- water soluble pen
- Small, sharp-tip scissors for cutting away applique
- USB stick compatible with your machine
- New embroidery needles
- Hand-sewing needle and thread
- Seam ripper
- 3 empty bobbins
- Your favorite tea, coffee or cocoa cup!
