Babylock Solaris Upgrade 2 Play Date

Supply List

Pattern: Created in class

Project description: Using the new features of the 2nd upgrade for the Solaris, create a unique machine cover for your Solaris machine!

NOTE: You must have a Babylock Solaris with upgrade 2 installed (or the new Solaris 2) in order to take this class.

PLEASE READ ALL OF THE INSTRUCTIONS AND "PRIOR TO CLASS" TASKS SO YOU WILL BE PREPARED FOR CLASS. WE WILL BE WORKING AT A QUICK PACE. ALSO, YOU MUST BRING ALL OF THE ATTACHMENTS LISTED BELOW AS THEY ARE SPECIALTY ITEMS AND THE STORE DOES NOT HAVE AN EXCESS INVENTORY ON HAND. DUE TO THE COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS, THE STORE IS OPEN TO FIVE CUSTOMERS AT A TIME SO CLASS PARTICIPANTS MUST WAIT THEIR TURN FOR PURCHASES.

Fabric requirements:

- 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards main fabric - choose a solid fabric or a fabric that "reads" as a solid
- 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards one sided fusible fleece or fusible pellaon batting (make sure it is not fusible on both sides)
- 8 inch square of solid fabric for applique - focal point of cover
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard fabric for pocket on back side of cover - this can be a print
- 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yard lining fabric
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard binding fabric
- 1 yard SF 101 (fusible interfacing)
- 2 yards ribbon for ties on the side - $\frac{7}{8}$ " wide to 1.5" wide
- Embroidery thread to contrast (or match) fabric - used for center applique and quilting - (bring 1-4 colors and you can decide as you create)
- Prewound bobbins or empty bobbins to wind matching bobbins
- Wonder clips or straight pins
- Frixion pen or chalk that you will use to mark the pocket sections

Supplies:

- Babylock Solaris with upgrade 2 installed or the new BL Solaris 2 machine
- Embroidery unit, embroidery foot, power cord, and FOOT PEDAL
- Universal foot (quarter inch foot and edge joining foot optional but helpful)
- Endpoint specification stickers - *next page includes a picture
- Dual function stylus with battery installed - next page includes a picture
- 10 $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 16" hoop

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ENDPOINT STICKER – YOU RECEIVED SHEETS OF THESE IN YOUR SOLARIS 2 UPGRADE



DUAL PURPOSE STYLUS – SITS ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF YOUR MACHINE – came with the Solaris sewing / embroidery machine

Please make sure the battery is installed and the stylus lights up when you press the button or you will not be able to use it in class.

NOTE: THE STICKERS WERE ENCLOSED WITH THE UPGRADE AND THE STYLUS CAME WITH YOUR MACHINE; YOU HAVE THESE ITEMS!

USB STICK OPTIONAL – we will digitize the machine cover in class; if you would like the power point presentation, bring a USB and we will download it for you for future reference

PRIOR TO CLASS:

From the background fabric cut:

24" X WOF; subcut to 24" x 34"

20" X WOF; subcut to 20" x 27"

From the one sided fusible batting / fleece cut (1) 24" x 34" and (1) 20" x 27" pieces

Fuse the batting to each of the background pieces on the wrong side of the fabric

From the pocket fabric cut (1) 18" x WOF; trim to 18" x 27" and fuse with SF101 interfacing

Press the pocket in half lengthwise with wrong sides together creating a piece that is 9" x 27"; bring this pressed and interfaced pocket to class

From the binding fabric cut (6) 2 ¼" x WOF strips and bring to class

Cut an 8" square of Pellon SF101 and interface the applique fabric IF your background fabric shows through the applique piece. In other words, if you are using a white applique fabric over a dark background fabric, interface the white so the dark fabric does not show through; sometimes the fabric that shows through changes the color of the applique piece.

NOTE: Due to COVID-19 restrictions, masks are required in the classroom. Eating in the classroom is not permitted; please be respectful of other guests who may be immune compromised. There will be a lunch break - no instruction will take place during this time. Feel free to bring your lunch or sit in your car or on the chairs provided outside.
