*You must have an embroidery machine in order to complete this project!

Pattern: Any of Hoopsisters Baby Animal Wall hanging patterns:

Leo the Lion

Eli or Ellie the Elephant

Frank the Frog

Harriet the Hippo

Gerge or Georgia the Giraffe

Project description: Create a zoo animal quilted wallhanging adding textured fabrics such as cuddle or flannel for a cute addition to any baby or child's room. The wall hanging can also serve as floor mat for tummy time for baby.

Fabric requirements: See pattern for fabric requirements as each pattern calls for different amounts of fabric. If you have any questions, ask a sales associate for assistance.

NOTE: Flannels, cuddle fabric, or other textured fabric add interest to these already adorable patterns.

Batting and backing according to pattern instructions. (I added batting before quilting for a puffier look to be used as a tummy mat)

Embroidery supplies:

Battilizer will be used instead of stabilizer; this can be purchased by the bolt or by the yard. You will need one piece of battilizer large enough to completely fit in the required hoop for EACH hooping of the wall hanging.

Embroidery thread of your choice - refer to pattern instructions

Vanish thread

Prewound bobbins or empty bobbins to wind your own

Applique scissor for trimming close to applique pieces

Other Supplies:

Embroidery machine with embroidery arm, hoop (see required hoop size on pattern instructions), embroidery foot, and power cord.

Sewing machine, quarter inch foot, foot pedal, and stitch in the ditch foot will be used during second class - construction and quilting of wall hanging

Regular thread for piecing such as Mettler

Rotary, cutter, ruler & mat - there are some in class room.

Battilizer - replaces stabilizer and batting

Pins, Wonder Clips, etc.

Thread snips and seam ripper (just in case)

Mono poly thread (invisible thread) for stitching in the ditch

PRIOR TO CLASS - IMPORTANT!

Download your machine's file format to a USB or save to your machine's memory
