

# ✦ Quilt Beginnings ✦ Cherry Pickin' Table Runner

**Date:** Friday, March 20

**Time:** 10 am - 3 pm

**Project description:** Take the Dresden Plate to the next level by making the blades patchwork of fabrics.

**Pattern:** *Cherry Pickin'* by Me and My Sister

**Fabric requirements:**

- 1 colorful charm pack or 42, 5 x 5" squares for blocks
- 1 yard background fabric
- $\frac{1}{2}$  yard binding
- 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  yards for backing

**Supplies:**

- Double Wide 4 Patch Dresden Template by Me and My Sister (Must have)
- Marking Pen
- 45 MM rotary with **SHARP** blade
- Mat and ruler
- Fusible Web Strips by Clover
- Thread for sewing blades
- Thread for topstitching the plate to background

**Special Note:** To save time in class, it would be helpful if you could complete sewing the 7 rows of 6 squares as shown on page two.

**Sewing supplies:**

1. Rotary cutter, 6 inch or 12 inch ruler and mat
2. Neutral thread, scissors to clip threads
3. Fabric marking pen
4. Sewing machine and accessories.
