Easter Garden Table Runner

Supply List

Instructor: Pam Churches

Dates: 10 a.m. - 4 p.m., Thursday, February 20th

NOTE: You must have an embroidery machine with minimum hoop size 6.5" x 8.5" in order to complete this project.

Required Pattern: *Easter Garden Table Runner* by Amelie Scott Designs

Project description: Create a festive table runner on your embroidery machine, then use the custom quilting to finish it. Finished size 11.5" x 36".

Fabric requirements:

- 1/3 yard background fabric for lilies and bunnies
- $\frac{1}{4}$ yard accent fabric (background for the eggs)
- 1/6 yard OR (2) 6" squares fabric for lilly appliques
- 1/6 yard OR (2) 5" x 8" rectangles for bunny appliques
- Scraps of fabric for eggs - there are a total of eight eggs
- Scraps of batting for appliques - batting is used under (8) eggs, (2) bunnies and (2) lilies
- 1 yard Pellon SF 101 Shape Flex interfacing
- 5/8 yard fabric for backing
- $\frac{1}{4}$ yard fabric for binding
- Batting - approximately 20" x 44" - large enough for table runner and an additional 4" on each side for quilting
- Stabilizer - pattern calls for wash away such as Floriani Wet and Gone; I prefer Floriani Stitch and Wash (enough for 12 hoopings)
- Embroidery tape such as RNK pink tape or Kimberbell embroidery tape
- Frixion pen or water soluble pen for marking top for quilting

Supplies:

- Embroidery / sewing machine, embroidery arm, embroidery foot, cord, foot pedal, and $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot for piecing top
- Pins or wonder clips for piecing

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Supplies cont'd

- Embroidery thread to match or contrast with appliques
- Thread for piecing
- Safety pins or basting spray to hold the three layers together
- Prewound and empty bobbins
- Applique scissors to trim appliques and thread snips

PRIOR TO CLASS:

- Download your machine's file format for the pattern to USB
- Print off all instructions
- Glance at the instructions for thread colors (ie. Bunnies detail, flower detail, etc.)

Prepare fabric as follows (Note: I cut my background fabric larger than the pattern instructions due to shrinkage during embroidery process)

- Background for bunnines
 - Cut 9" x width of fabric; subcut (6) 7" x 9" pieces
 - Interface with Pellon SF101
- Background for eggs
 - Cut 7.5" x width of fabric; subcut (6) 4.5" x 7.5"
 - Interface with Pellon SF101
- Bunny fabric - cut (2) 5" x 8"
- Lilly fabric - cut (2) 6" squares
- Eggs - (8) squares approximately four or five inch squares
