**Project description:** Heirloom Centerpiece using both Cutwork and Trapunto techniques. Learn how to make a beautiful cutwork Centerpiece using tonal threads and fabrics to give the design an elegant look.

**Embroidery design:** Anita Goodesign Heirloom Centerpiece from the Mini Heirloom Collection. Included with class. Will be provided as an email download.

**Fabric requirements for Size "A" (adjust accordingly for other sizes)**

- Base fabric 9" x 9" (8 Pieces of Base Fabric this size)
- Batting 8" x 8" (12 pieces of Batting this size)
- Wash-away stabilizer (4 pieces minimum to fit your hoop, bring enough to double layer-which would mean 8 just in case)
- Embroidery thread to coordinate with design
- Bobbin to fill with Embroidery thread (top and bottom thread must match for cutwork)
- 1 spool all-purpose sewing thread

AA (Size - 8.7" x 8.7") A (Size - 7.7" x 7.7") B (Size - 6.7" x 6.7")

**Sewing supplies:**

1. Rotary cutter, ruler and mat (or all pieces pre-cut)
2. Sewing machine with embroidery unit and accessories
3. Embroidery hoop to accommodate size you are making
4. Linen fabric (tighter weaves work best for cutwork)
5. Embroidery Thread & **matching bobbin** to complement fabric
6. Wash away stabilizer enough for a total of four Hoopings
7. Applique scissors—I like the duckbill style
8. Seam Ripper
