Required Pattern: Janine Babich's "*Home Sweet Home*" Embroidery CD

NOTE: You must have an embroidery machine with minimum 6"x8" hoop in order to complete this project.

Project description: Learn the basics of machine embroidery and machine applique as you create this adorable three piece table topper. You will complete at least one of the sections in class. |

Fabric requirements:

- 1/3 yard background fabric (also used for the back of each piece)
- 2 1/2 " x 3" scrap of fabric for the beehive - this is the only fabric piece; all other details use thread only
- 1/4 yard fusible fleece
- 3/4 yard Pellon SF 101 interfacing
- Tearaway stabilizer - I use Floriani "stitch and wash" - there will be three hoopings plus three pieces of floating stabilizer for a total of six lengths of stabilizer needed
- Embroidery thread to coordinate and contrast with your fabrics - refer to CD cover for color suggestions
- 12" of grosgrain ribbon for hanging loops (1/4", 1/2" or 5/8")
- 1/4" or 1/2" Steam a seam tape (approximately 1 yard)
- Scotch tape
- Trip Tic three piece wire stand

Embroidery Supplies:

Embroidery machine, embroidery arm, power cord, embroidery foot and minimum hoop 6" x 8"; larger hoops are optional; I do not recommend using a magnetic hoop for this project.

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Sewing Supplies:

Thread snips

Applique scissors

Precision point turner

Prewound bobbins or empty bobbins to wind

If you have a small iron and ironing pad, feel free to bring it; otherwise classroom irons are shared

PRIOR TO CLASS:

Download your machine's file format to USB and bring to class

Print off all instructions (3 pages) and bring to class

Fabric preparation - please do this so we can complete as much as possible in class

Cut (3) 5" x 9" pieces of background fabric and interface with Pellon SF101 - it is easier to interface fabric first then cut to size to prevent fusible interfacing sticking to your iron or ironing surface

Cut (6) 5" x 5" squares of background fabric and interface with Pellon SF101

Cut (6) pieces of 4 1/8" x 7 1/2" fusible fleece

Interface the scrap of beehive fabric with Pellon SF101

Cut grosgrain ribbon into (6) 2" pieces

Due to COVID19 restrictions, the class is limited to 12 participants, each utilizing their own table. Masks must be worn at all times in class.

Please make sure you bring all of the pieces and parts for your machine as the store does not have an excess inventory of machine accessories.
