Quilt Accessories Trio

Supply List

Dates: Friday, 10 a.m. - 4 p.m, March 20th and April 3rd

NOTE: You must have an embroidery machine in order to complete these projects.

Pattern: Hoopsisters *Quilt Trio Accessories (EmbroidaBlock Accessories)*

Project description: Create three projects using your embroidery machine to get perfect flying geese. You will create a carry all bag using vinyl, an acrylic ruler or "trimmer by George" cover, and a large or small rotary cutter case. In the first class, we create the flying geese that are used in all three patterns. Finish them up at home then come back to the second class where we will sew them all together.

Fabric requirements: The sample uses a main fabric, background fabric for the geese, and three flying geeses colors. The amounts listed below are enough for the tote, acrylic ruler cover, and both the large and small rotary cutter covers:

- 1 yard main fabric (white with black dots used in store sample)
- 1 yard background for geese (sample uses black)
- $\frac{1}{4}$ yard of three different fabrics - geese triangles
- $1\frac{1}{2}$ yards lining fabric
- $\frac{5}{8}$ yard vinyl
- 1 package *Aunties Two Patterns Happy Handles Kit*
- $\frac{1}{4}$ yard fabric to cover handles
- Tear away stabilizer such as stitch and wash or tear away
- Vanish thread
- Embroidery thread for quilting
- Neutral thread for piecing
- (1) package 18" x 58" Hoopshape by Hoopsisters

PLEASE SEE OTHER SIDE FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

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- Pony Tail bands or thin elastic (one per each rotary cutter case and one for acrylic ruler case)
- Decorative button for each of the above - will attach to pony tail holder
- Basting glue such as Roxanne Glue-Baste-It to hold vinyl in place
- Straight pins and wonder clips (a must)

Embroidery Supplies:

- Embroidery machine, embroidery arm, embroidery foot, power cord, and hoop
- Sewing accessories for your machine including $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot and narrow edge joining foot for top stitching; foot pedal
- Optional - small iron and ironing station; if you have a wool pressing mat be sure to bring it to the second class
- Kimberbell tape or RNK pink embroidery tape

PRIOR TO CLASS - BE SURE TO READ THIS

- PRINT OFF ALL INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE USB - there are three separate sets of instructions
- Download your machine's file format to your machine memory or a USB; depending on your machine, you may have to move your file format to a separate stick
- Precut your fabric for the rotary cutter case as listed on page 3 of the instructions "rotary cutter case large and small" found in the blue box. If you want to cut the fabric for the other projects, cut and place in separate bags. The more you have cut, the faster the embroidery process will go.
