Required CD: OESD Reverse Applique Notebook Covers

Note: You must have an embroidery machine with a minimum hoop size of 8"x12" in order to complete this project. There are five cork notebook covers for a 5"x7" notebook and five companion cork notebook covers for a 4"x6" notebook.

Project description: Learn how easy it is to do reverse applique as you create a cute cork notebook cover. The video features the peacock reverse applique for a 5"x7" notebook.

Fabric requirements:

Two pieces of medium tear away stabilizer (1 to fit hoop, 1 to float beneath hoop)

1 piece of 15"x18" cork - packages available at Quilt Beginnings - you should be able to complete one large and one small notebook cover with one package of cork

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard of fabric for peacock body

1/3 yard SF101 fusible interfacing

Spray adhesive such as 505 spray

Embroidery tape

Embroidery threads for decorative stitches

Prewound bobbin plus one empty bobbin

As per the instructions on the CD (page 8), cut the following:

1 piece of cork 11" x 7.5" for outside cover

2 pieces of cork 3" x 7.5"

1 piece of fabric interfaced with SF101 cut 11" x 7 1/2"

1 piece of fabric interfaced with SF101 cut 5.5" x 7.5"

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
