## Sew My Soles

### Supply List

**Instructor:** Zandra Shaw assisted in classroom by Pam Churches

**Dates:** Friday, October 16<sup>th</sup>, 12 - 4 p.m. - Join Zandra Shaw for a virtual class in our event center with Pam assisting you with your questions.

**Required Pattern:** *Sew My Soles* Espadrille Shoe Pattern / Kit by Zandra Shaw

NOTE: You must have an embroidery machine with minimum hoop size 6" x 8" in order to complete this project.

**Project description:** Create a unique pair of quilted espadrille shoes using Zandra Shaw's embroidery pattern and shoe kit; soles (included in kit) must be ordered prior to the class; soles are available in whole sizes only. The quilted tops will be constructed with your embroidery machine, stitched with your sewing machine, then hand sewn together with the supplies provided in the required kit.

#### **Fabric requirements:**

6-9 different fabrics for the quilted shoe

If using six fabrics - 6" x WOF

If using nine fabrics - 6" x 12"

1/3 yard fabric for lining

1 or 2 embroidery threads for construction and / or quilting

All other supplies are in the purchased kit.

#### **Sewing Supplies:**

- Embroidery machine, embroidery arm, embroidery foot, power cord and hoop
- 6" x 8" hoop is minimum required; if you have a larger hoop be sure to bring it
- Sewing accessories for your machine including  $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot, general purpose sewing foot (and ankle if applicable), accessory tray (some machines do not allow you to sew with the embroidery arm attached; you will need to convert your embroidery machine to a sewing machine to finish construction of shoes)
- Pre-wound bobbin with neutral color thread and an empty bobbin to wind matching thread (just in case)
  - **PLEASE SEE REVERSE SIDE FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

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- Thread snips, seam ripper, and long blade scissors (you will be trimming around the edges of the embroidered pieces)
- Small iron and ironing mat if you do not wish to use iron provided in classroom
- Smaller applique scissors for trimming edges of individual pieces
- Frixion pen that can be seen on your fabric choices
- Edge joining foot is optional but very helpful
- Hand sewing needle for closing the openings on the four parts of the shoe
- Small ruler helpful - 6" or less with 1/8" markings
- Jeans needle (size 90) optional but very helpful sewing through the layers during the construction process

## **PRIOR TO CLASS:**

Download the instructions using the information provided on the card inserted with your kit

Use the download code to access your digital downloads

Print off all of the instructions and bring to class

Download your machine's file format (and shoe size) to your USB stick

Due to COVID19 restrictions, masks are required at all times in the classroom. Please make sure that you bring all of your supplies to class; the store does not have an excess inventory of hoops, etc. Also, if you wish to purchase items, there is a limit of five customers in the shop at a time so you will be required to wait in line for purchases.
