## Twilight BOO-levard

### Supply List

**Instructor:** Pam Churches

**Dates:** Friday, September 25<sup>th</sup>, 10 a.m. - 4 p.m.

**Required Pattern:** Kimberbell's *Twilight Boo-levard Bench Pillow CD*

**Project description:** Create an adorable 16" x 38" bench pillow, wall hanging, or table runner that lights up with miniature twinkling lights. Kimberbell's use of 3-D embellishments make this project both fun to create and enjoy.

**NOTE: You must have an embroidery machine with minimum 5" x 7" hoop in order to complete this project.**

PLEASE READ ALL OF THE INSTRUCTIONS AND "PRIOR TO CLASS" TASKS SO YOU WILL BE PREPARED FOR CLASS. WE WILL BE WORKING AT A QUICK PACE. ALSO, YOU MUST BRING ALL OF THE MACHINE PIECES AND PARTS AS THEY ARE SPECIALTY ITEMS AND THE STORE DOES NOT HAVE AN EXCESS INVENTORY ON HAND. DUE TO THE COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS, THE STORE IS OPEN TO FIVE CUSTOMERS AT A TIME SO CLASS PARTICIPANTS MUST WAIT THEIR TURN FOR PURCHASES.

**Fabric requirements:**

Refer to back cover of CD for Kimberbell fabrics or use your own fabric stash. Kits are also available at the store.

1 yard Pellon SF101 fusible interfacing for background blocks.

Embellishment kit available at store; this project uses various types of embellishments such as mylar, glitter vinyl, clear vinyl, and two battery operated light strings to name a few. Kimberbell has created an embellishment kit with everything needed to complete this project.

Embroidery thread to match or contrast your fabrics

Pre wound bobbins or empty bobbins to wind thread (suggested for blocks with sayings)

5" x 7" hoop for most blocks; if you have 6x10 or 8x12 hoop (or larger) bring it - all blocks can be completed in the 5x7 hoop but will only require a single hooping if you use your large hoop; 4x4 hoop great for signs

Roll of tear away stabilizer - I prefer stitch and wash

Wash away stabilizer for sign embellishments - I prefer Wet and Gone or OESD Aquamesh

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## **Supplies:**

Embroidery machine with embroidery arm, power cord, and embroidery foot  
1/4" foot and foot pedal (we may not get far enough in class to sew the blocks together but be prepared in case)

Applique scissors, seam ripper, thread snips

Pillow form (will be discussed in class) if you wish to make a bench pillow

Pins and wonder clips for completing project

General sewing and embroidery supplies

## **PRIOR TO CLASS:**

Download your machine's file format to a USB

Print off all instructions from the CD

Pre-cut all of your fabric - refer to page 3 and page 5 of your instructions

To help you stay organized, place fabrics in individual bags as described on page 2 of instructions "Getting Started"

Refer to page 4 of instructions and prepare embellishments

Interface all of the background blocks with Pellon SF101 - You have  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of background fabric - you might wish to interface this piece first, then cut as shown on page 5 of your instructions.

You might want to glance through the instructions for embroidery thread suggestions. Kimberbell has included a colored block prior to each numbered step showing the thread color they used for their fabrics. Make sure you bring a yellow or gold thread for lights!
