Baby Lock Serger Club Scout Tee

Dates: Wednesday, April 3, Noon-4 p.m.

Techniques: Straight seams, bias facing, set-in sleeves, and hemming

All Tools, Sewing Supplies, and Notions are available at Quilt Beginnings.
Please purchase your supplies BEFORE the day of class. QB staff will help you!

Pattern is Required for this class:

Grainline Studio, Scout Tee (Sizes 0-18 included in the pattern)

Rayon Fabric rolls are available for the tee. If you select a woven fabric from the bolt, check your pattern for the fabric yardages related to your size. If you are between sizes, choose the larger size. Choose woven fabric (not stretch) from Quilt Beginnings that is 45-inches wide. Please do not choose a plaid or directional fabric.

Tools and Sewing notions:

1. Baby Lock serger; You will use overcast and cover hem applications
2. Serger accessories, tables, tools, feet, power cord, and foot pedal
3. Scissors
4. Wonder Clips
5. NEW Serger 12/80 needles in your machine
6. 4 cones of serger thread to match your fabric
7. Seam ripper
8. Six-inch stitch gauge (Dritz)
9. Fray Check
10. Iron and pressing surface

Preparation before the first Class

1. Gather supplies and tools for class as stated above. QB staff will help you.
2. Wash your fabric as you plan to wash after your garment is made. (Preshrink)
3. Iron your fabrics. (Best Press works great.)
4. Cut out your tee fabric according to the size you need. (SEE PAGE 5 OF YOUR PATTERN)
5. Read through the instructions before class to familiarize yourself.
6. Bring a snack and drink with lid if desired.
