NOTE: You must own a Babylock Solaris or Destiny embroidery machine in order to complete this project.

Project description: Create a 16 1/2" square redwork pillow top with your Babylock IQ designer on your Destiny or Solaris embroidery machine utilizing the built in IQ shapes and the continuous border feature in embroidery. Finish off your pillow with a professional covered zipper back.

Pattern created in class (as always, you will receive detailed handouts on how to recreate this pattern)

Fabric requirements:

- 2/3 yard fabric for the pillow front (solids or fabrics that read as a solid are the most suitable for the pillow top)
- 2/3 yard fabric for pillow back - choose any coordinating fabric
- 1/6 yard (6 inches) fabric for flap to cover zipper and zipper stops - this fabric can be the same as the backing fabric or choose something entirely different (note: zipper stops will not be seen as they will be under zipper cover)
- 18" square pillow form
- Embroidery thread that highly contrasts with fabric chosen for pillow front
- 2/3 yard battilizer by Hoopsisters (this takes the place of batting and stabilizer and keeps the pillow top much smoother with less puckering)
- 1 ½ yards Pellon SF101 or sew lazy fusible interfacing
- **SNOWMAN PLACEMENT STICKERS**

Sewing supplies:

1. Embroidery machine with embroidery unit, embroidery foot, and power cord

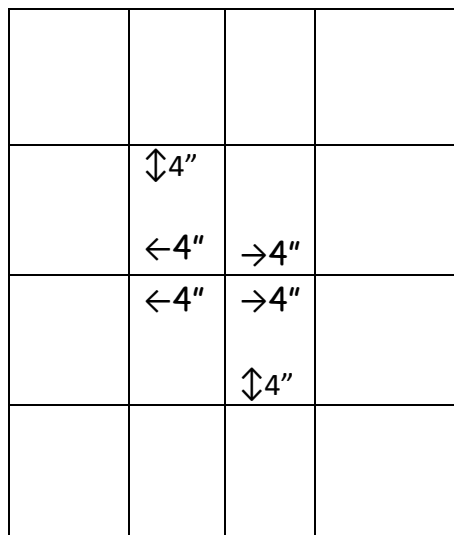
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2. 9.5" square hoop or 9 1/2" by 14" hoop
3. Empty bobbin for embroidery - you will need two bobbins that match the embroidery thread you have chosen
4. Scissors to clip threads
5. 1/4" foot for sewing
6. Neutral thread for pillow construction
7. Foot pedal for sewing pillow together
8. Pins
9. Frixion pen or other NON-permanent fabric marking pen

Prior to class:

Cut a 24" square of pillow top fabric and 22" square pillow back fabric. Cut two 22-23" squares of interfacing and fuse one piece to the wrong side of both the pillow top and pillow back centering on the back of the fabric. Both pieces will be cut to size later.

Using a frixion pen, draw a horizontal line and a vertical line on the FRONT of the pillow fabric through the horizontal and vertical centers. Draw another line 4" to the left and 4" to the right of the vertical center line and 4" above and 4" below the horizontal center line.



Cut the six inches of zipper cover fabric approximately 6" x 24". Fuse the remaining six inches of interfacing the wrong side of this fabric.

Bring interfaced and marked pieces to class.
