Project description: Cutwork Table Topper. Learn how to make a beautiful cutwork Table Topper using tonal threads and fabrics to give the design an elegant look. Two finished sizes to choose from: 8" x 23" (requires 240mm x 150mm Hoop) or 6.5" x 20.5" (requires 130mm x 180mm Hoop)

Embroidery design: Purchase separately

Project supply requirements:

- Large Table Topper - Linen 8.5" x 24" (1/4 yd will do two)
- Medium Table Topper - Linen 7" x 21"
- Matching polyester embroidery thread (40 or 50 wt.) or color of your choice (two cones needed). We will wind bobbins from the same thread as the top
- Wash away stabilizer - enough to double layer in hoop 6 times

Sewing supplies:

1. Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
2. Sewing machine with embroidery unit and accessories
3. Embroidery hoop 5 x 7 or 6 x 10 larger
4. Embroidery Thread & matching bobbin to match linen
5. Wash away stabilizer-we will use two layers for each of 6 embroideries
6. Applique scissors (I like the duckbill style)
7. Seam Ripper
8. Zig zag foot
