Dazzling Diamonds

Supply List

Instructor: Cathy Daum

Dates: 10am-3pm on Feb. 8, March 8, April 5 and May 10

Project description: Cathy will help guide you through the creation of this beautiful quilt by Jacqueline de Jonge using strip piecing and paper piecing techniques. This project requires precision piecing and is not advised for the beginning quilter. The quilt finishes at 74" square.

Pattern: *Dazzling Diamonds*

Fabric requirements:

You will need to select 3 graduated colors (a light, a medium, and a dark) from 8 different color families. You want the medium and dark to be close in value, with the light being the spark.

NOTE: Batik kits (with fabrics designed by Jacqueline de Jonge used to create her quilt) will be available for \$119 with the background, borders and binding purchased separately

1/8 yd. for each light (8)

1/2 yd. for each medium (8) and dark (8) fabrics

6-1/2 yd. background

5/8 yd. small stripe for accent

1-3/8 yd. for border and binding

5 yd. for backing.

Sewing supplies for the first class:

Rotary cutter, mat and a ruler at least 18" long

Sewing machine with 1/4" foot

Zip lock bags

Seam ripper (just in case), thread snips, fine pins, fabric marker

Prior to class: Nothing required. Come ready to have fun! Might want to pack lunch or bring a snack.
