Project description: This flannel quilt was made using the “Color Wash” line by Bonnie Sullivan for Maywood Studios. The colorful blocks are quickly and accurately pieced in strip sets. This quilt is 68” square.

Pattern: Hopscotch by Bonnie Sullivan required.

Fabric requirements listed on the back of the pattern. (Kits are available at Quilt Beginnings)

1 3/4yd Khaki fabric for blocks and borders

1 3/4yd Black fabric for blocks and binding

12 Fat Quarters of fabrics A-O listed on the back page of the pattern

1/2yd of fabrics E,H,M listed on the back page of the pattern

4 1/4yd of flannel backing fabric

Sewing supplies:

1. Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
2. Sewing machine and accessories
3. Neutral thread, scissors to clip threads
4. 1/4 inch Foot
5. Alphabitties (available at Quilt Beginnings) handy for organizing cutting stacks, or pins, wonder clips.

Prior to class: Please follow the cutting directions as noted on the back page of the pattern for each of noted fabrics. There is no need to prewash your flannels. The focus of the class will be piecing the colored nine patch blocks and surrounding coordinate blocks.
