### Description 65.5" X 65.5 MACHINE EMBROIDERY AND PIECED QUILT

This machine embroidered and pieced quilt is designed by Amanda Murphy for Bernina's 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

*\*\*\*At least an intermediate skill level in piecing/sewing/embroidery is recommended to create this precision-pieced quilt in this class. You must know how to operate confidently your sewing and embroidery machine.*

8 yards of 1/16" or 1/8" cording for binding piping

Precision cutting is key to your success! Take your time. *Measure thrice and cut once.*

Jubilee designs on a flash drive (Design #80190-04 Modified, #80091-01, #80190-19)

Cut Fabric C (Cornerstones) See cutting directions in your pattern.

Cut Fabric D (Border) See cutting directions in your pattern.

Cut Fabric G (Embroidery only-white highlights). See cutting directions in your pattern.

Cut Fusible Woven Stabilizer. See directions in your pattern

Bring all your fabrics, scraps, interfacing, tearaway to class.

Bring your machine, module, hoops, and Jubilee embroidery designs.

Double check your list of supplies. Pack up!
