**Project description**: Create a simple table runner using Christine's easy embroidery method. You will first embroider the snowflakes, piece the runner, then quilt in the hoop. Finished size is 15" x 36". Love this runner? Create Christine's monthly runners using the same technique!

NOTE: Required stitch field:  $7" \times 8.5"$  (180 mm  $\times$  220 mm) - machines with smaller hoop sizes will not meet minimum stitch field requirements.

Required Book: Trapunto Snowflake Runner by Amelie Scott Designs

## Fabric requirements

- 1 yard background fabric (cut into twelve 7" x 8.5" pieces)
- 1 yard backing fabric
- $\frac{1}{4}$  yard accent fabric (cut into 48 two-inch squares)
- $\frac{1}{4}$  yard organza (optional) cut into 12 four-inch squares)
- $\frac{1}{4}$  yard snowflake fabric (cut into 12 four-inch squares)
- $\frac{1}{4}$  yard binding fabric
- Twelve 4" squares of batting
- $1\frac{1}{2}$  yards Pellon SF 101 stabilizer (cut into twelve 7" x 8.5" rectangles)
- Floriani Wet and Gone Stabilizer enough for twelve hoopings
- Embroidery thread for snowflakes and quilting
- Empty bobbin for quilting; prewound bobbin may be used for embroidery
- RNK pink embroidery tape
- Water soluble pen or other NON-permanent marking pen
- Basting pins or basting spray for quilting your table runner

## Sewing supplies:

- 1. Embroidery machine including power cord, embroidery arm, embroidery foot, power cord and hoop
- 2. Sewing machine and accessories including foot pedal and  $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot to sew blocks
- 3. Neutral thread to stitch blocks together
- 4. Scissors to clip threads
- 5. Applique scissors to trim snowflakes

## Prior to class:

- 1. Please download your machine's format to your USB stick
- Also, so that you may use your time stitching instead of cutting, please have all your fabrics cut prior to class. (see cut measurements listed under fabric requirements above.) This includes background fabric, snowflake fabric, accent fabric, optional organza, pellon interfacing and batting.
- 3. Press the twelve pieces of Pellon interfacing to the wrong side of the twelve pieces of background fabric.
