Project description: Floral Cutwork Tea Towels. Learn how to make beautiful cutwork Tea Towels using tonal threads and fabrics to give the design an elegant look. Purchase two tea towels (we have them) for this project. I will also demonstrate how to create tea towels from scratch using linen & a wing needle for a lovely hem.

Embroidery design CD: Anita Goodesign Express, Project 14, Floral Cutwork Tea Towels (Included in Class Fee)

Fabric requirements

- Two linen towels
- Optional project requires 20" x 32" linen for a towel from scratch & a wing needle

Sewing supplies:

1. Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
2. Sewing machine with embroidery unit and accessories
3. Embroidery hoop 5 x 7 or larger
4. Two linen towels (available at Quilt Beginnings)
5. Embroidery Thread & matching bobbin to match towels
6. Wash away stabilizer enough for a total of four layers to fit your hoops (two for each towel)
7. Applique scissors (I like the duckbill style)
8. Seam Ripper
