Project description: Learn to paper piece using Carol Doak's fast and easy method.

Required Pattern: *Floral Wreath* - MH Designs

Fabric requirements

- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard background fabric
- Roll of 8 floral fabrics available at store OR 1/8 yard of 8 different fabrics

Sewing supplies:

1. Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
2. Sewing machine and accessories
3. Neutral thread
4. Scissors to clip threads
5. **Add a quarter ruler - 6" or 12" is needed for this project**
6. Press bar - optional (used to press seams) - not the pressing bars used for applique; if you have a small cutting mat, desktop ironing board, and miniature iron - feel free to use these at your table
7. Simple Foundations Paper (translucent vellum).

Prior to class:

Make four copies of the pattern on vellum; if you are unable to make copies, bring your vellum to class and we will make them for you; if we make the copies it must be the "simple foundations" paper as our copier will not copy other brands.
