Project description: Remember the connect the dot books that we used as children to draw out characters and objects? The fabric line for this quilt Spooktacular captures that idea in "Dot, Dot, Boo". Pick up the coordinating fat quarter bundle to make this simple to piece quilt. This quilt measures 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Pattern Required: Layers of Charm by Me and My Sisters Designs

Fabric requirements (on back of the pattern). I used the coordinating 12 piece Fat Quarter bundle to make this quilt. Additionally, I added 4 fat quarters (as I did not want to repeat the colors in the 16 large color blocks). However, there are enough fabrics in the 12 Fat Quarter bundle to make the entire colored blocks.

- Dot Dot Boo Fat Quarter Bundle. If you want pick up 4 additional fat quarters.
- 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ yards of background fabric
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yards of binding
- 4 yards of backing fabric
- Batting for a Lap Size quilt

Sewing supplies:

1. Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
2. Sewing machine and accessories
3. Neutral thread
4. Scissors to clip threads
5. $\frac{1}{4}$ Piecing Foot
6. **Bring a sack lunch and drink**

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Prior to class:

From the Fat Quarters:

For the small block - from each color way cut 2, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, Cut 4, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Keep like prints together. *Note my cutting instructions call for doubling the cutting from the pattern since we are not using Charm Packs. You will have enough pieces to complete the 36 small blocks.

For the large block - choose 16 prints (or duplicate 4 colors if you did not pick up additional fat quarters). Cut 1, $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Cut 2, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles Keep like prints together.

From the Background fabric follow the directions listed on page 2 in the pattern:

Cut 15, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 - inch strips

From 9 of the strips cut 144, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " inch squares. From the remaining 6 strips cut 144, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

Cut 12, $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. From 8 of these strips cut 64, $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. From the remaining 4 strips cut 64, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
