Stars & Stripes

Project description: All you need is one jelly roll and one yard of fabric to put these stars and stripes together. It's so easy, you'll come close to completing your top in class!. Bring a sack lunch to keep your energy up!

Required Pattern: *Block Magazine, Summer Vol 5, Issue 3*

Fabric requirements

- 1 jelly roll
- 1 yard of fabric (to contrast with stars)

Sewing supplies:

1. Rotary cutter, 24" ruler and mat
2. Clearly Perfect Angles Tool (optional, but very helpful)
3. Sewing machine with $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot, open toe foot (optional) and accessories
4. Scissors to clip threads

Prior to class:

Follow cutting instructions on page 60 for the background fabric. You will need forty 4" squares and eighty 2-1/2" squares. Set aside the remaining background for the small inner border.

Choose **TEN** of your darkest 2-1/2" fabric strips for the stars. Set the remaining strips aside. Cut each strip into four 2-1/2" x 6" rectangles and four 2-1/2" x 4" rectangles.
