## Mom and Me 9 Patch

### Supply List

**Instructor:** Cheri Taylor

**Dates:** Tuesday, August 7, 2018 - 11AM-4PM

**Project description:** a fun, fast, and easy version of a traditional quilting favorite, the 9 patch block. The quilt measures 40 X 54" but can be made larger with an additional border. This does take longer and isn't recommended for a first time sewer.

**Book:** *Provided in class*

**Fabric requirements:**

- 1 1/8 yards of focus fabric for the center AND
- 1/4 yard of a coordinating fabric for the cornerstones
- 1 1/8 yard of another coordinating fabric for the border
- 1 3/4 yards fabric for the back
- A batting to fit - you can also use flannel or fleece for the back and no batting

Note: If you plan to add an additional border, purchase 1 1/2 yards for that border and 3 yards for the back.

**Important Note:** If you are using a directional print anywhere in the quilt, please add 1/4-1/3 yard extra fabric for matching.

**Sewing supplies:**

- Sewing machine and accessories
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
- Safety pins (a must for or layering!) AND straight pins for stitching
- Sewing supplies including a seam ripper and scissors
- Thread for piecing and for quilting
- Lunch for you & your sewer

**Prior to class:** If possible, familiarize the child with the machine you are bringing and talk about how much fun we'll be having. Washing and pressing the fabric is up to you.
