Dates: 10 a.m. - 5 p.m., Tuesday, August 21st and Wednesday, August 22nd

NOTE: You must have an embroidery machine with a minimum hoop size of 5" x 7" in order to complete this quilt.

Project description: Create a cute Halloween wall quilt with three dimensional embellishments while increasing your machine embroidery skills. Finished size is approximately 51" x 64".

Required pattern: *Broomhilda's Bakery* by Kimberbell

Fabric requirements are listed on pages 3-6 in the required book.

Embellishments are listed on page 6 - note that most embellishments will be used during the class.

- Fabric kits and embellishment kits are available at Quilt Beginnings or be creative and choose your own color selection
- If you purchase the embellishment kit you will also need five pieces of felt; pattern requires **four pieces of black 9"x 12" pieces of felt and one piece of orange 9"x 12" piece of felt.**

Embroidery supplies:

- No show mesh stabilizer - will be needed for the flying geese blocks created in the hoop
- Medium Tear away stabilizer or Stitch and Wash by Floriani is used for the majority of the embroidered blocks - please note that although the stitch and wash is usually recommended as a wash away stabilizer, it is difficult to wash away. However, it is a very soft tear away stabilizer and works very well in this quilt
- Wet and gone or similar wash away stabilizer for embellishments
- Embroidery threads to match and / or contrast with your fabrics
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of Pellon SF 101 interfacing - optional -for use when applique fabric is lighter than background fabric - this product will keep the background fabric from shadowing through your applique



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- Embroidery machine with embroidery unit, embroidery foot, power cord and a 4"x4" hoop as well as a 5"x 7" hoop. Using the smallest hoop required will save on stabilizer and help secure your background fabric by hooping
- RNK Pink embroidery tape
- Frixion pen for marking fabric
- Orange Pop rulers by Kimberbell - optional - these rulers come in square sizes and rectangle sizes; although they are not required, they make trimming your blocks much easier; they will be demonstrated during class
- Blue roller pressing bar - optional but very helpful for creating perfect flying geese blocks in the hoop
- $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot and foot pedal for your machine for sewing picture blocks together

LUNCH: Please bring your lunch or a snack each day!

Other notions:

- Applique scissors to trim your applique pieces
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper
- Empty bobbins
- Prewound bobbins may be used for most of your applique blocks

Prior to Class:

- Pre-cut all your fabric as instructed on pages 3-6 of your pattern book
- Sort your fabric in bags as you cut. For example, cut the candy corn fabric and place it in a bag. Cut the next fabric (black floral) and place it in another bag. If you are using your own color assortment, tape a small piece of the fabric over the fabric swatch on pages 3-6 in your book. As you prepare to embroider a block, you will know which fabric you are using or which replacement fabric you have chosen. You can then gather the fabrics needed for the block we are working on from the assorted bags of fabric.
- Transfer your machine's file format embroidery files for the quilt to a USB stick so you will be ready to embroidery at the beginning of class.
- This quilt is not hard. The blocks stitch out fast and are very basic but collectively, they make a beautiful keepsake quilt!
- Most importantly, **DO NOT STRESS**. This is supposed to be fun. If you have questions, stop in the shop prior to class and we will be happy to assist you in any of your preparations.
