**Pattern:** AccuQuilt Blooming Blocks Sampler (included in the **Go! Serendipity Qube**)  
Sampler Quilt (26" x 41"); Shooting Star block (sample) 11" x 11"

#### **Program description:**

AccuQuilt and Edyta Sitar have teamed up to create the *Go! Serendipity Specialty Set Qube*. Creating the six flower-basket-block sampler is a great way to use up your scraps and successfully master working with small pieces and beautiful applique'. We will also demonstrate how to create the unique Shooting Star block included in the set.

There is an embroidery CD included in the Qube, however, it is not compatible with the sampler quilt. The best part of this class is the digitized files that will be provided for you, thank you to the great skill and collaboration from Libby Van Treese and Cathy Daum! Make sure you bring your USB stick! ☺

#### **Fabric requirements:**

- 2 1/4 y. light fabric will give you ample material  
(2/3 y. for backgrounds)  
(2/3 y. for quarter square triangles)  
(1/2 y. for borders)
- 1/4 y. brown(s)  
(Six 6" squares for baskets and handles)
- Assortment of greens for stems and leaves  
(Scraps work great for these or 1/8 y. cuts)
- Assortment of blues, yellows, oranges, pinks, etc. for flowers  
(Scraps work great for these or 1/8 y. cuts)
- Assortment of colorful scraps  
(about 2/3 y. total for quarter square triangles)
- 1/6 y. colorful scraps  
(or twelve (4 3/4") squares of the same fabric for cornerstones)
- Binding: 1/3 y.
- Backing: 1 3/8 y.
- Medium Weight Tearaway Stabilizer
- 1 yard Lite Steam-a-Seam 2

## Supplies:

- **AccuQuilt Go! Serendipity Specialty Set** (make sure you bring the included cutting mat)
- AccuQuilt 2 ½" strip cutter is optional, but if you have it, feel free to bring it for cutting your borders/binding. Don't forget your mat!
- AccuQuilt Cutting System of your choice (the Go! Baby is perfect for this project) If bringing the Go! Big cutter, remember your cord!
- Sewing/Embroidery machine and accessories (foot pedal, power cord, embroidery module, etc.)
- Embroidery Hoop: at least 200 x 260 (8 x 10)
- USB stick compatible with your machine
- Embroidery and piecing feet for your machine
- Colorful thread to match your fabric scraps for embroidery
- Neutral thread for piecing
- Spare sewing embroidery needles
- Thread snips, pins and Seam ripper
- Small rotary cutter and mat
